ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE (A.A.) - Transfer

State College of Florida, Manatee-Sarasota (SCF) offers one associate in arts (A.A.) degree.

A total of 36 general education credits is required and a minimum of 24 credits is required in the elective area.

Liberal Arts and Sciences [1058] This curriculum classification is for students who, upon graduation from SCF, transfer to a public or private college/university to earn a baccalaureate degree in a specific area of study.

Below are areas of study at Florida public and selected private colleges/universities for which students may prepare while completing the associate in arts degree at SCF. Academic advisors are available to assist with program planning so that the proper academic program prerequisites are taken prior to successful transfer to the university/college from SCF.
