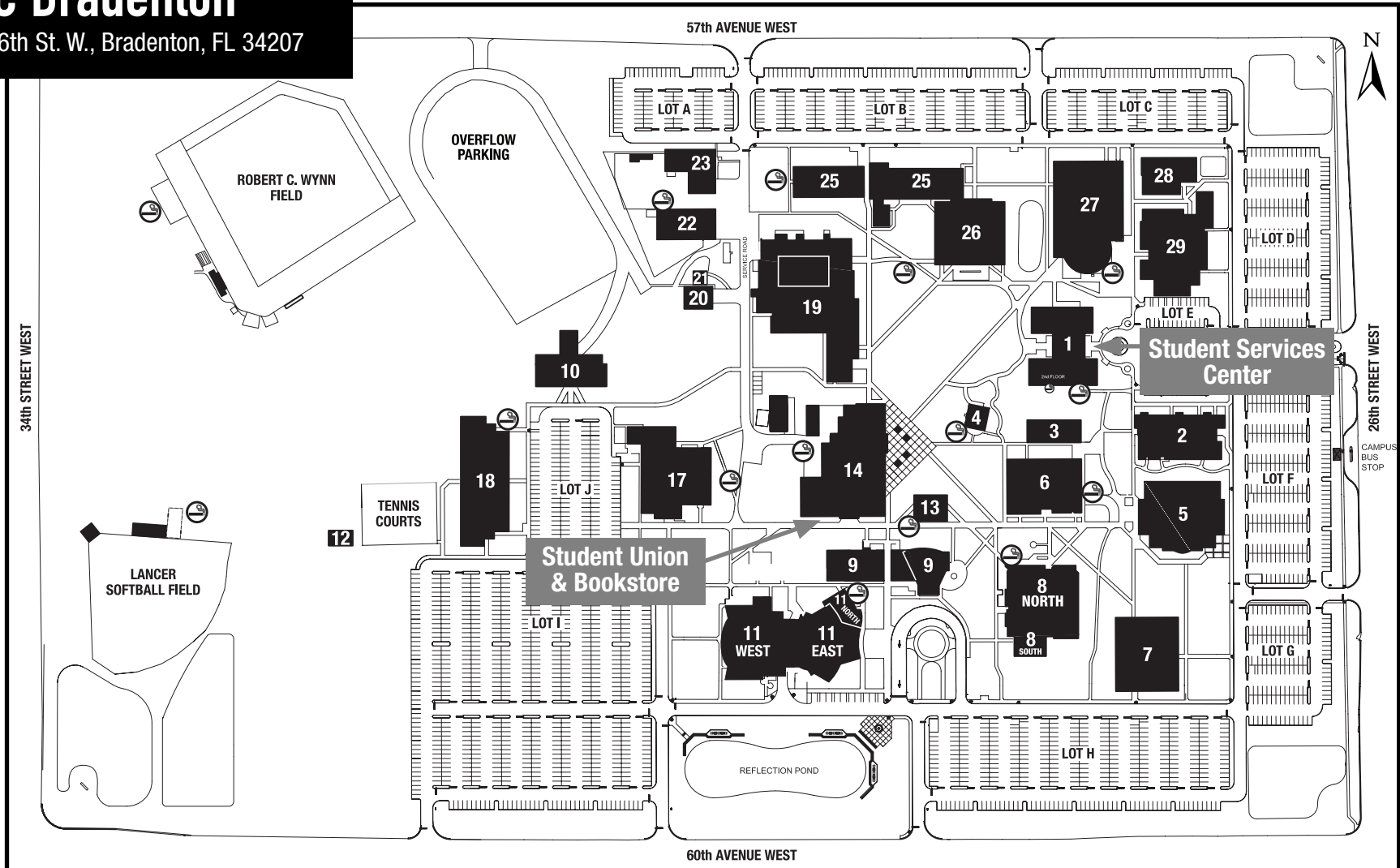

Bldg. 1–Student Services Center

Registrar, assessment/testing, advisement and recruitment, international student services, financial aid, veteran services, disability resource center, career resource center, cashier and other support functions.

Bldg. 2–Radiography Lab and Dental Hygiene Clinic

Bldg. 3–Faculty Offices

Bldg. 4–Campus Ministry

A large meeting room, office, kitchen area and a smaller meeting room.

Bldg. 5–Academic Resource Center

Reading, writing, mathematics, language and S.A.I.L. labs and the arts and letters & social and behavioral sciences dean of instruction office.

Bldg. 6–Computer Center

The computer center, telecommunications and institutional research.

Bldg. 7–Office Complex

Central administrative offices including the office of the president; vice presidents of academic affairs; business and administrative services; and planning and institutional effectiveness; conference rooms; offices of business services; finance; human resources; public affairs and marketing; resource development and The Foundation for MCC Inc.

Bldg. 8–NORTH: Library - Books, electronic resources, online databases, videotapes, slides, audiotapes, disc recordings and public access electronic catalogs. **SOUTH: Family Heritage House** - Black history memorabilia.

Bldg. 9–Social Science Building

A faculty office complex, classrooms and state-of-the-art geography lab.

Bldg. 10–Art & Design

Art faculty offices, computer labs for graphics program, film program classrooms and printmaking, photography and ceramics studios.

Bldg. 11–EAST: Neel Performing Arts Center - Features seating for 839 and wheelchair accessible seating and restrooms. **WEST: Music and Theatre Building** - The adjacent Music and Theatre Building contains a studio theatre, music rehearsal room, music classrooms, music practice rooms and faculty offices. **NORTH: Fine Art Gallery** - The Fine Art Gallery is located next to the Neel Performing Arts Center lobby.

Bldg. 13–Performance Pavilion

Bldg. 14–Student Union

Food services, Lancer Café, public safety, Lancer Bookstore, Club Hub and Student Government Association.

Bldg. 17–Gymnasium

A full court for college games, athletic department offices and weight rooms.

Bldg. 18–Professional Development Center

Offices, seminar rooms, classrooms and registration facilities for programs offered by Corporate and Community Development institutes of workforce development, continuing and community education and traffic safety. Business faculty offices also are housed here.

Bldg. 19–Technology

The business and technology department, the offices of the dean of instruction for the division of mathematics, science, business and technology and director of career and technical education, classrooms and labs to support various technology programs.

Bldg. 23–Facilities Planning and Maintenance

Bldg. 25–Science

Bldg. 26–Science Labs

Labs for biology, chemistry, microbiology, anatomy and physiology, faculty offices, several preparation areas for lab work and a personal electron scanning microscope.

Bldg. 27–Mathematics

Facilities for teaching mathematics and some business, accounting and economics classes, and the mathematics department offices.

Bldg. 28–Occupational Therapy Assistant and Physical Therapist Assistant

Bldg. 29–Nursing

A teaching auditorium and classrooms; audiovisual, computer, nursing skill laboratories, office suite and conference rooms; and the office of the dean of nursing and health professions.
