Fall 2018

April 2, Monday	Web registration begins for all active students (including dual enrollment) continuing for Fall 2018 classes with 45+ earned credit hours.
April 3, Tuesday	Web registration begins for all active students continuing for Fall 2018 classes with 30–44 earned credit hours.
April 4, Wednesday	Web registration begins for all active students continuing for Fall 2018 classes with 15–29 earned credit hours.
April 5, Thursday	Web registration begins for all active students continuing for Fall 2018 classes with 0–14 earned credit hours.
April 9, Monday	Web registration begins for all new students (including dual enrollment) transfer, transient, readmits, and all others not previously registered for Fall 2018 classes.
May 15, Tuesday	All required documentation must be received, including placement testing and course registration for all dual enrollment and early admission students at both the high school campus as well as SCF for the summer and Fall 2018 term.
July 2, Monday	All required documents must be received by the Financial Aid Office to ensure all eligible financial aid awards. Documents received after this date will be processed in the order they were received by the Financial Aid Office. Students should pay for their classes by the established pay dates if funding is not in place at that time.
August 7, Tuesday	All tuition and fee payments due for Fall 2018 term classes. All Fall 2018 class schedules not secured with full payment or financial aid by 11:59 p.m. will be cancelled for non-payment.
August 10, Friday	Summer 2018 grades posted to student transcripts.
August 13, Monday	Last day for students to submit third-attempt fee waiver forms for Fall 2018 classes. First day to use financial aid in the SCF Store.

August 16, Thursday	<p>Faculty return.</p> <p>Last day placement testing offered to new students for classes that begin August 20–25.</p>
August 17, Friday	<p>Last day of new student orientations for Fall 2018 classes beginning August 20–25.</p> <p>Last day new student applications (including readmission applications) will be accepted for Fall 2018 term classes that begin August 20–25.</p> <p>Last day for submission of residency documentation for Fall 2018 term classes that begin August 20–25.</p>
August 20, Monday	<p>Fall 2018 classes begin.</p>
August 25, Friday	<p>Last day to change course from credit to audit status.</p>
August 31, Friday	<p>Last day to use financial aid in the SCF Store.</p>
September 3, Monday	<p>Labor Day holiday. College closed.</p>
September 4, Tuesday	<p>Last day for students to change degree/program/major for the Fall 2018 term. All changes after this date will be effective for the Spring 2019 term.</p>
September 5, Wednesday	<p>Financial aid enrollment-census date for the Fall 2018 term. Total credit hours registered on this date will be used to establish financial aid eligibility. All future class registrations after this date will not be eligible for federal financial aid for the Fall 2018 term.</p>
September 7, Friday	<p>Last day to submit an application for Fall 2018 graduation.</p>
October 1, Monday	<p>An “I” grade not previously completed for the Spring 2018 and/or Summer 2018 term will be changed to an “F” on the student’s permanent record.</p>
October 12, Friday	<p>All College Day. No classes or academic-support labs. Classes scheduled 4:00 p.m. and later will meet as usual.</p>

November 2, Friday	Deadline to submit the graduation attendance form online to guarantee participation in December 13, 2018 Winter Commencement ceremony.
November 12, Monday	Veterans Day holiday observed. College closed.
November 13, Tuesday	All required documents must be received by the Financial Aid Office to ensure funding of tuition and fees at the beginning of the spring term. Documents received after this date will be processed in the order they were received by the Financial Aid Office. Students should pay for their classes by the established pay dates if funding is not in place at that time.
November 22–23	Thanksgiving holidays. College closed.
November 30, Friday	All required documentation must be received and placement testing completed for all dual enrollment and early admission students at both the high school campus as well as SCF for the Spring 2019 term.
December 7, Friday	Fall 2018 classes end.
December 10–13	Final examinations for Fall 2018 classes.
December 13, Thursday	Winter Commencement, Bradenton Area Convention Center.
December 14, Friday	Final grades due at 2:00 p.m. for all Fall 2018 classes.
December 17, Monday	Fall 2018 grades posted to student transcripts.
December 17, 2018 –January 6, 2019	Winter holiday break (no classes).
