End-of-Program Student Learning Outcomes

- 5.) Integrate **leadership skills in the various nursing roles**: manager and provider of care, advocate, teacher, and as a member of the nursing profession.

- 7.) Employ information literacy skills to identify current evidence through the effective use of informatics to communicate, manage knowledge, improve the quality of patient care, and support decision-making for clients, families, and communities.
