To Receive Credit:

- Enroll in one of the career, technical or academy programs at your school.
- Complete the program with a B average or better and earn an overall unweighted GPA of 2.5 or better.
- 3. Meet with your school counselor to learn more about the application process and free college credits that may apply and meet other articulation requirements, as applicable.
- Complete and mail the form or online survey.
- 5. Enroll at a TBCPC participating College in the certificate or associate of science degree program that correlates with your high school or technical school program within 2-3 years of taking the class or classes.
