As a Hernando, Hillsborough, Manatee, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk and Sarasota County Schools graduate, you may receive FREE college credit for high school and technical programs at these local state colleges Hillsborough Community College, Pasco Hernando State College, Polk State College, St. Petersburg College, and State College of Florida (Manatee-Sarasota) and the participating School Board.

Your free credits may be applied to Certificates Associate of Science degrees provided you meet the requirements outlined in the partnership agreements.

To Receive Credit:

1. Enroll in one of the career, technical or academy programs at your school.
2. Complete the program with a B average or better and earn an overall unweighted GPA of 2.5 or better.
3. Meet with your school counselor to learn more about the application process and free college credits that may apply and meet other articulation requirements, as applicable.
4. Complete and mail the form or online survey.
5. Enroll at a TBCPC participating College in the certificate or associate of science degree program that correlates with your high school or technical school program within 2-3 years of taking the class or classes.
