Why did the claimant move to Florida? State statute is very specific about who is eligible to receive in-state tuition. If the primary reason you moved to Florida was to pursue an education, you are NOT eligible to receive in-state tuition. (As stipulated in Section 1009.21(2)(a)2, F.S., "it is imperative that the required 12-month qualifying period be for the purpose of maintaining a bona fide domicile rather than for the purpose of maintaining a mere temporary residence or abode incident to enrollment in an institution of higher education." In other words, if you moved to Florida to earn a degree from State College of Florida, Manatee-Sarasota (SCF), you are not eligible to receive in-state tuition.)

Please keep in mind that your reason cannot be for educational purposes, or you will automatically be ineligible to receive in-state tuition. It is also difficult to justify your move for other than educational reasons, if you immediately start school as a full-time student upon moving to the state.

Provide compelling evidence for residency for tuition purposes at SCF. (Examples: employment opportunity, family ties, etc.)
