Intent for Independent Students (Only complete this section if student is categorized as independent)

Why did the claimant move to Florida? State statute is very specific about who is eligible to receive in-state tuition. If the primary reason you moved to Florida was to pursue an education, you are NOT eligible to receive in-state tuition. (As stipulated in Section 1009.21(2)(a)2, F.S., "it is imperative that the required 12-month qualifying period be for the purpose of maintaining a bona fide domicile rather than for the purpose of maintaining a mere temporary residence or abode incident to enrollment in an institution of higher education." In other words, if you moved to Florida to earn a degree from State College of Florida, Manatee-Sarasota (SCF), you are not eligible to receive in-state tuition.)

Please keep in mind that your reason cannot be for educational purposes, or you will automatically be ineligible to receive in-state tuition. It is also difficult to justify your move for other than educational reasons, if you immediately start school as a full-time student upon moving to the state.

Provide compelling evidence for residency for tuition purposes at SCF. (Examples: employment opportunity, family ties, etc.)

Citizenship The student and claimant (if not the student) must be eligible to apply for Florida residency for tuition purposes. To qualify as a Florida resident for tuition purposes, you must be a U.S. citizen, a foreign national in a nonimmigrant visa classification that grants you the legal ability to establish a bona fide domicile in the United States, a permanent resident alien, or a legal alien granted indefinite stay by the U.S. C.I.S.
