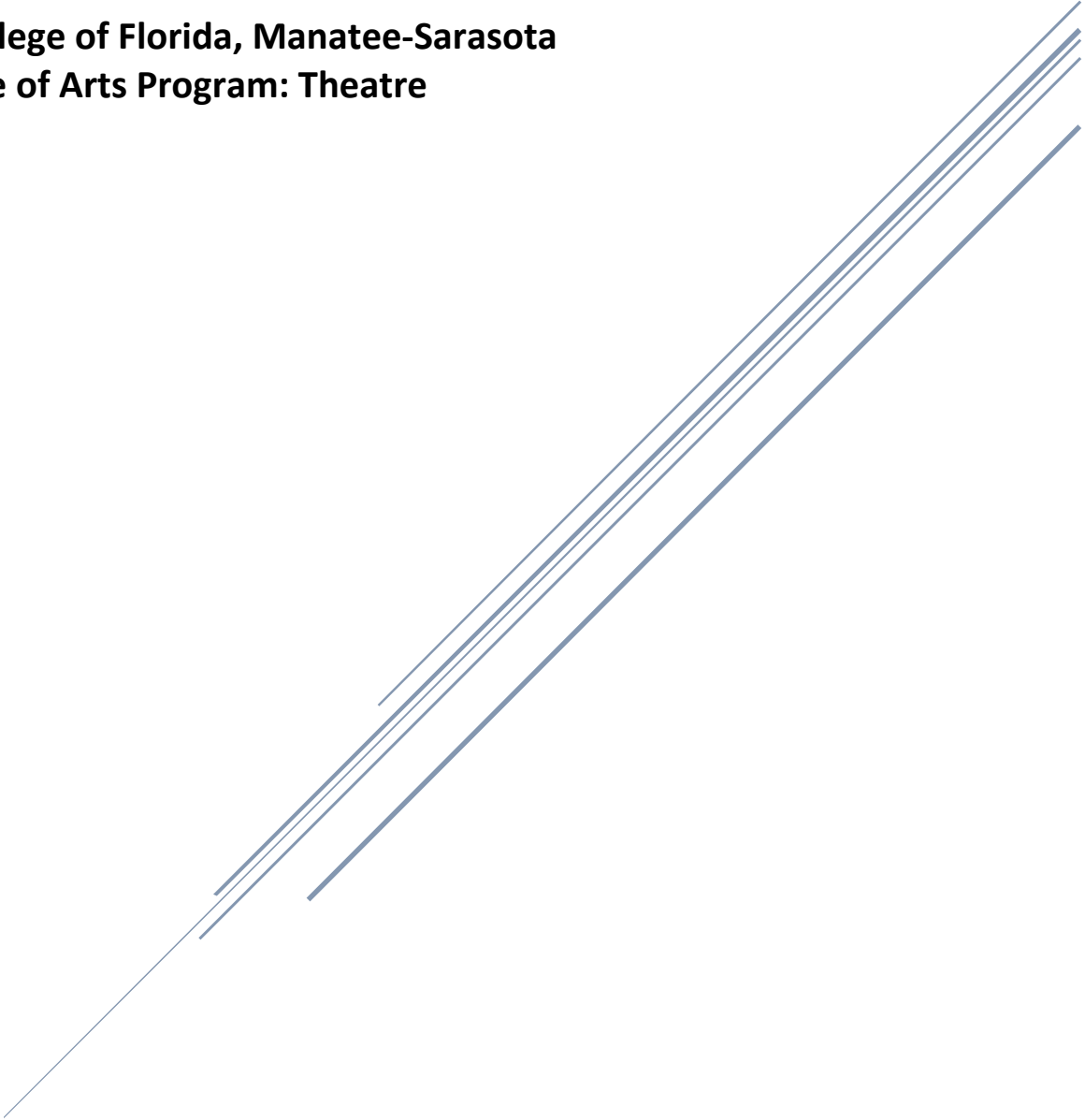

### Academic Pathway – Transfer Pathway Theatre
