Foreign Language: Per 1007.25FS and rule 6A-10.02412 students who are first-time-in-college students in Fall 2014 or late must demonstrate foreign language competency (consult Degree Works)

SCF Graduation Requirement: At least 25% of the hours of course credit required for the degree must be completed at SCF (SCF, catalog).
