## **General Requirements:**

Civic Literacy (CL): Per 1007.25FS requires students initially entering the FCS/SUS institution in 2021-2022 and thereafter to complete a course  $\underline{and}$  an assessment to demonstrate competency in civic literacy (consult Degree Works).

**Gordon Rule\*\*:** Per rule 6A.10.030 requires students to complete four writing courses with a grade of C or better and are required to complete a minimum of six credits hours of mathematics with a grade of C or better in each course (consult Degree Works)

**Foreign Language**: Per 1007.25FS and rule 6A-10.02412 students who are first-time-in-college students in Fall 2014 or late must demonstrate foreign language competency (consult Degree Works)

**SCF Graduation Requirement:** At least 25% of the hours of course credit required for the degree must be completed at SCF (SCF, catalog).
