Submit:

- Complete Residency Documentation
- OFFICIAL High School Transcripts or GED
- OFFICIAL transcripts from previous colleges
- Joint Services Transcripts for Military Service

## ○ Test – Assessment & Testing Center

- Submit ACT, SAT, or PERT scores w/in last 2 years
- or, proof of successful completion of college math/English readiness courses
- Veterans and AD Military may be exempt, but consider taking PERT if it's been awhile since you were at school

## ○ Financial Aid – FAFSA – see Financial Aid

## ○ Disability Resource Center (DRC)

Veterans with a Military-related disability may qualify for assistance and should consider Chapter 31 VR&E 941-752-5295 (B), or 941-408-1448 (V)

## VA Benefits Application process

- If applying for first time education benefits:

> **Veterans** complete form **22-1990** at [va.gov](http://va.gov).

> **Dependents** complete **22-1990E** (33 Transfer of Entitlements), or **22-5490** (Chapter 35) at [va.gov](http://va.gov).

> Submit copy of your **Member 4 DD-214 (Veterans)** or **Notice of Basic Eligibility** (NOBE for Reserve/Guard).

> Submit **Certificate of Eligibility** to a Veteran Advisor. (email PDF copies, please)

## ○ TA – Tuition Assistance

- Ask your unit Education Office about TA
- Submit approved, signed TA Authorizations to SCF Veterans Services

## ○ Activating your VA Education Benefits

- Immediately after you register for classes, or add/drop or withdraw from classes, you must submit a **VA Request for Certification** via [SCF.edu/admissions/Veterans](http://SCF.edu/admissions/Veterans)

- Once received, your SCO will put a Deferment Hold on your account to stop any drop for non-payment
